#### CONSULTATIVE STATUS

Secretariat memorandum prepared by the Directorate of Political Affairs

1. In accordance with Resolution (72) 35 of the Committee of Ministers on relations between the Council of Europe and international non-governmental organisations, the Secretary General notified the Committee of Ministers and the Consultative Assembly of his proposals regarding, additions which he was - considering making to the list of organisations enjoying consultative status on 11 September 1973 (CM (73) 170 and Doc. 3324).
2. In the absence of objections as described in paragraph 10 of Resolution (72) 35, the Secretary General's proposals were to be deemed to be decisions of the Committee of Ministers on expiry of a period of 6 months from the date of that notification.
3. Requests were received before the expiry of this period for the files of 2 organisations nominated by the Secretary General to be examined in accordance with paragraph 10 of the above resolution, as follows:
  - a. the United Towns Organisation, 4 parliamentarians from 3 different countries requested, on 25 January 1974, that the file of this organisation be examined by the Committee on Regional Planning and Local Authorities, and the Consultative Assembly will therefore be asked to adopt a recommendation on the report of the competent committee for the attention of the Committee of Ministers, which will take a final decision the matter;

  - b. the International Association against painful experiments on animals: the Governments of Sweden, Denmark, the United Kingdom, Italy and Iceland have requested, under, paragraph 10, a decision on the matter from the Committee of Ministers.

The Secretariat will prepare the documents for discussion and enter this item on the draft agenda for a forthcoming meeting of the Ministers' Deputies.

4. In accordance with paragraph 9 of Resolution (72) 35, the 23 international non-governmental organisations listed below enjoy consultative status with the Council of Europe as
